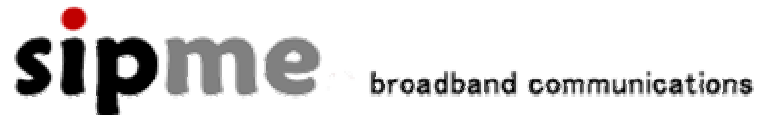


VOIP (X-Lite[®]) Set Up Notes

First plug the mike jack in to the top left socket (the pink one).
Then plug the earphone jack in to the bottom right socket (the brown one).

Then, when the motherboard drivers auto-detect something tell the computer it is a 'Headphone'.



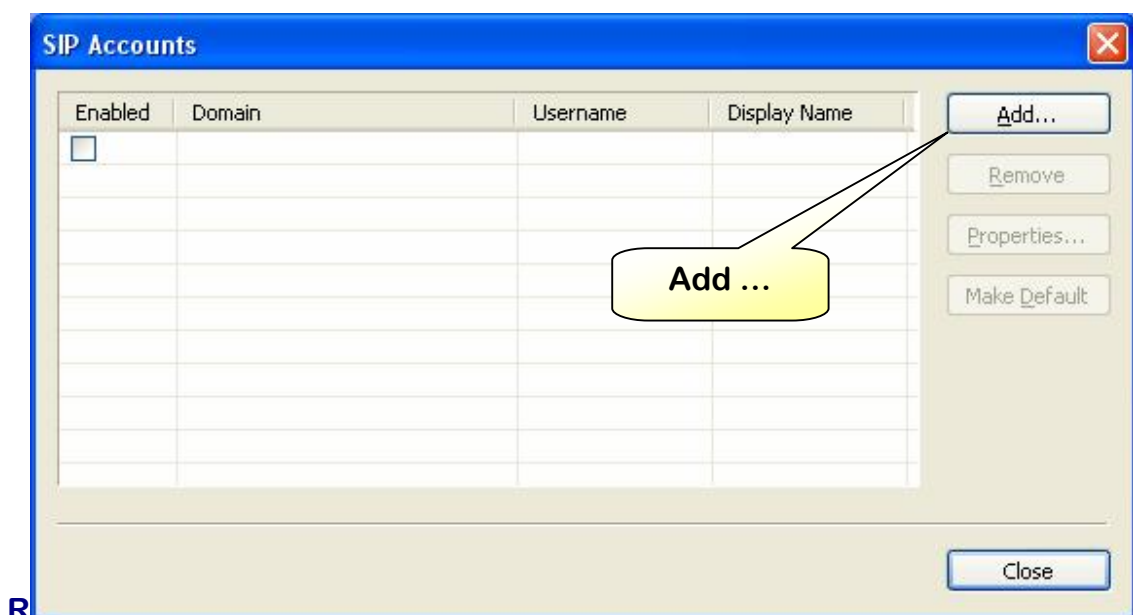
Confirm that the jacks are in the right spots.

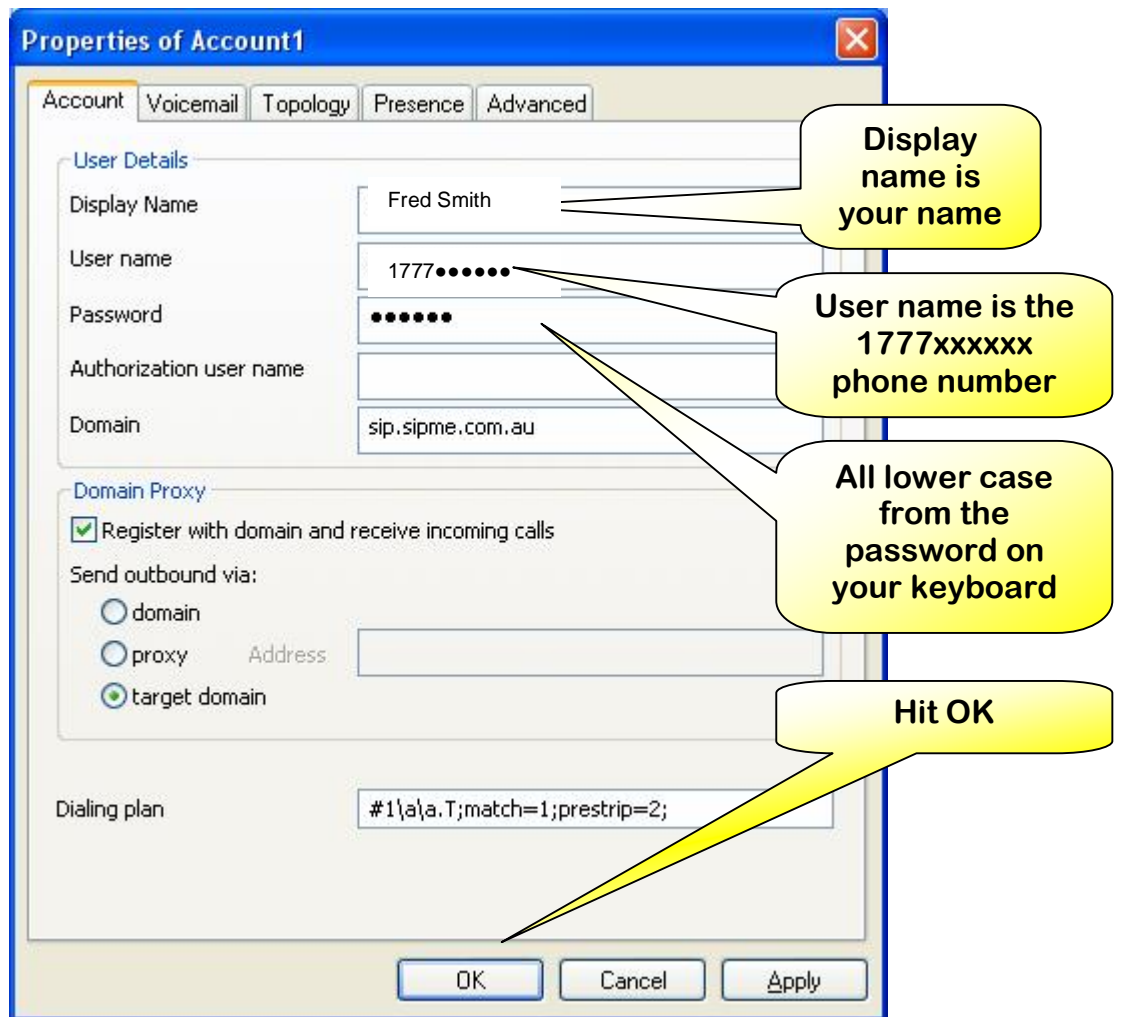


Now beef up the mike levels.



Now to set up the phone settings, right click on the phone and open account settings.





So it should look like this.



Right click on the phone again and open 'Options'
